You are welcome to join us for this program, whether you are just learning or you've been playing chess for some time.

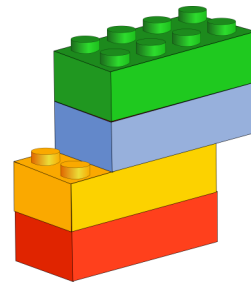

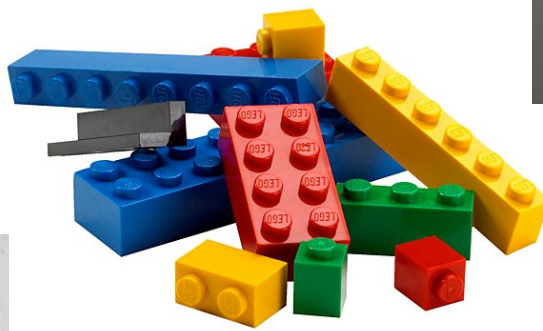
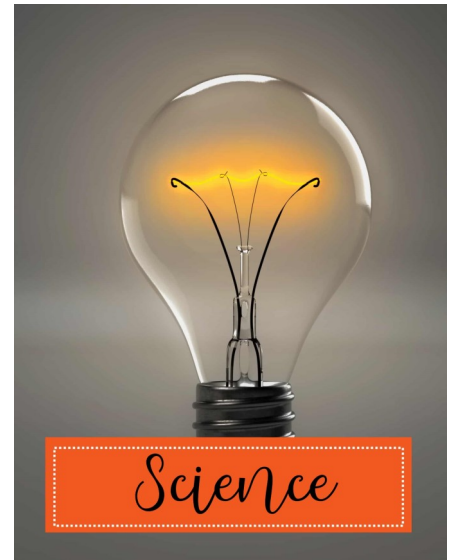
